

About Consul Jehlik

Wayne Jehlik holds a degree from the University of Washington-Seattle in Russian, East European and Central Asian studies.

Currently, Consul Jehlik is the president of the non-profit group Center for Czech Education and Culture. They work to unite the United States and Czech Republic in areas of culture, education & civil society. He also is a member of the leadership council of American Friends of the Czech Republic.

At the University of Washington he sits on the advisory board at the department of Slavic Languages and Literature. The Advisory Board aims to promote future opportunities for students in the Pacific Northwest to learn about Slavic language, literature, and culture. Also during his time at the University of Washington, Consul Jehlik founded the Czech Studies Endowment.

Previously, Consul Jehlik worked with the Foundation for Russian-American Economic Cooperation. The Seattle based foundation worked for two decades to foster better economic and cultural ties between the United States, Soviet Union, and then Russia.
