Anne Lise Church was appointed consul for the Republic of Seychelles in 1994 and since has become extremely active in promoting tourism, trade development and exceptional relations between the United States and Seychelles. Ms. Church has established an export business of United States wine between Seychelles and the United States. She is currently working on establishing imports from Seychelles to the United States. She was promoted to consul general in 2001.



Lise Church is very active in charity work. In honor of her contributions she was made Dame of the Diplomatic Society of the Knights of St. Gabriel in 2008 (St. Gabriel is the Patron Saint of the Diplomats). She also founded the Friends of Seychelles, a charity organization located in Seattle, in 1997, and she is a Paul Harris Fellow in Rotary International.
